

Chapter 6 ALCOHOL BEVERAGES*

On March 13, 2012, the County Board adopted ordinance revisions to codify Resolution No. 39-11, which restructured the County Board committees, boards, and commissions in anticipation of the downsizing of the County Board from 29 to 15 supervisors. Not all ordinance subsections were revised, but those subsections that had material changes will be specifically designated at the end of those subsections.

- (a) The statutory provisions of Wis. Stats. § 125.07 describing and defining restrictions and penalties with respect to underage and intoxicated persons; presence on licensed premises; possession and penalties are adopted and by reference made a part of this section as if fully set forth herein. Any act required to be performed or prohibited by Wis. Stats. § 125.07, incorporated herein by reference, is required or prohibited by this section. Any further amendments, revisions or modifications of the statutes incorporated herein are intended to be made a part of this section effective on the date such amendments become law.
- (b) The following subsection headings are set forth for reference:
- (1) Sales of alcohol beverages to underage persons.
 - (2) Sale of alcohol beverages to intoxicated persons.
 - (3) Presence in place of sale.
 - (4) Underage persons, prohibitions, penalty.
