

**Chapter 18 COURT\***

On March 13, 2012, the County Board adopted ordinance revisions to codify Resolution No. 39-11, which restructured the County Board committees, boards, and commissions in anticipation of the downsizing of the County Board from 29 to 15 supervisors. Not all ordinance subsections were revised, but those subsections that had material changes will be specifically designated at the end of those subsections.

**Sec. 18-1. Clerk of court to collect fees.**

The clerk of court shall collect fees and suit tax on a cash basis as well as through accounts receivable. A check for the total amount of fees paid by cash or charged to accounts receivable shall be turned over to the county treasurer at the end of each month when the transactions occur. A check for the total amount of suit tax shall be turned over to the county treasurer at the end of the quarter when the transactions occur.
