**Nonmetallic Mining and Reclamation**

Notice is hereby given that the **No Mercy Excavating** has filed an application for a Conditional Use Permit and a Nonmetallic Mining Reclamation Permit to meet the requirements of the Chippewa County Zoning and Nonmetallic Mining Reclamation Ordinances.

Location: **SW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of NW<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> of Section 24, T28N-R10W**  
Owned by: **Daryl Wojcik**

The applicant proposes to: **extract, crush, and screen sand and gravel material to be used for general construction purpose, and to store and stockpile recyclable demolition waste. The post-mining land use will be reclaimed to agricultural production, managed using a perennial forage conservation cover with the potential for converting to moderate to high intensity commercial development. The proposed mine site covers approximately 60 acres and will be sequentially mined and reclaimed in progressive stages.**

A combined hearing on the conditional use permit application and reclamation plan will be held on Thursday evening, November 17, 2016, in Room 302 of the Chippewa County Courthouse. The hearing, pursuant to Chippewa County Zoning Ordinance Ch.70-34 and NR 135.20(2), will commence at 7:00 p.m.

The reclamation portion of the hearing will be conducted for the purpose of explaining and receiving comments from affected persons on the proposed mining and reclamation.
