Notice is hereby given that **Stelter, Inc.** has filed an application for a Conditional Use Permit and a Nonmetallic Mining Reclamation Permit to meet the requirements of the Chippewa County Zoning and Nonmetallic Mining Reclamation Ordinances.

Location:     **NE ¼ of SE ¼, of Section 06, T30N-R08W**  
Owned by:    **Charles & Cathy Morning**

The applicant proposes to: **extract, crush, and wash sand and gravel, and to establish the post-mining land use as an undeveloped wildlife pond and upland grassland wildlife habitat. The proposed mine site covers approximately 34 acres and will be sequentially mined and reclaimed in progressive stages.**

A combined hearing on the conditional use permit application and reclamation plan will be held on Thursday evening, November 17, 2016, in Room 302 at the Chippewa County Courthouse. The hearing, pursuant to Chippewa County Zoning Ordinance Ch.70-108 and NR 135.20(2), will commence at 7:00 p.m.

The hearing will be conducted for the purpose of explaining and receiving comments from affected persons on the proposed mining and reclamation.
