

# CHIPPEWA COUNTY TIMBER SALE TRACT 20-16

## Fishpole Lake Drainage Selection Harvest

Located in Sec. 3 and 10 T31N R8W Town of Cleveland

Total Sale Area: (approximately 45 acres)

The table below contains an estimate of the amount of each species/product. There is no minimum bid for each species; however **the total minimum bid that is acceptable for Tract 20-16 is \$ 20,924.00.**

### Sale Area Description:

The boundaries of this sale are marked with red paint lines. The topography of this site contains well-drained hills, wetlands in depressional areas, and a perennial stream runs through the timber sale area. Oak and northern hardwoods will be thinned to include creation of canopy gaps designed to encourage oak regeneration within the stand. The Hay Meadow Horse Trail runs through the stand.

### Cutting Requirements:

Selection Harvest Area : Cut all trees marked with orange paint, including non-commercial trees marked with orange paint. Do not cut sale boundary trees (red paint) or trees that are marked with yellow paint to identify riparian management zones subject to equipment limitations.


### Special Conditions:

- Oak Wilt and Threatened Wildlife Species Restrictions apply: No harvesting or other operation is allowed within the site between April 15 and August 24.
- No harvesting activity will be allowed if rutting occurs.
- The sale is located adjacent to the Hay Meadow Horse Trail which is heavily used, particularly in the fall. Contractors must exercise extra caution when operating near the trail and the trail must be kept free of slash and logging debris and leveled when sale operations are complete. The horse trail will be heavily marked with ribbon (by horse riders) to assist logging contractor with identification of the trail.
- Timber mats or other approved temporary crossings will be required, the location and installation/removal of mats must be approved by County Staff. County timber mats are available for use, at no charge, on a first come first served basis.
- No equipment operation is allowed within riparian management areas (i.e. stream corridor and wetlands). The County has identified most of these areas with a yellow paint line but a few additional, relatively small wetlands may exist, which are also subject to equipment prohibition.
- All logging debris must remain within the sale boundaries and kept from wetlands, lakes and trails.
- There are two existing landings. All merchantable timber that is removed along landings or skid trails must be utilized and accounted for through mill slips or log scales.
- *Leave all snags (dead trees) unless they present a safety hazard. Use caution to limit the disturbance of Course Woody Debris (CWD) on the forest floor. (ie) down logs greater than 12 inches in diameter.*
- All hardwood logs, (except aspen) 10" or larger on the small end will be charged at the appropriate saw log stumpage rate.
- The contract length is 2 years.
