

## **CHIPPEWA COUNTY TIMBER SALE TRACT 6-17**

### **Tealey Creek Aspen Regeneration**

Located in Sec. 5 and 8 T32N – R7W Town of Birch Creek

Total Sale Area: (approximately 28 acres)

The table below contains an estimate of the amount of each species/product. There is no minimum bid for each species; however **the total minimum bid that is acceptable for Tract 6-17 is \$ 30,300.00.**

**Sale Area Description:** THIS SALE IS AVAILABLE FOR WHOLE TREE HARVESTING.

This timber sale is approximately 1 mile west of 300<sup>th</sup> Ave (a/k/a Maxfield Road) along the Tealey Creek Game Loop. Hauling from this timber sale will utilize the ATV/Snowmobile Trail to 300<sup>th</sup> Ave. The boundaries of this timber sale are marked with a red paint line. Portions of the timber sale area and access road are relatively wet and will require firm ground, but may be accessible under unfrozen conditions. The site is flat and the Tealey Creek Game Loop provides open areas that can be utilized for landings. Interested bidders should assume that the County will replace the culvert and add fill over the culvert that is between the ATV/Snowmobile Trail and the timber sale.

### **Cutting Requirements:**

Aspen Regeneration area: (Approximately 28 acres) Cut all trees one inch in diameter and larger except boundary trees and any trees marked with purple paint. Do not cut any conifers.

### **Special Conditions:**

- The County must approve all landings.
- No harvesting activity will be allowed if rutting occurs.
- All logging debris must remain within the sale boundaries and kept from wetlands and trails.
- The contract length is approximately 2 years, the effective expiration date will be March 31, 2019.
- *Leave all snags (dead trees) unless they present a safety hazard. Use caution to limit the disturbance of Course Woody Debris (CWD) on the forest floor.* (ie) down logs greater than 12 inches in diameter.
- If whole tree harvest is conducted, the "Wisconsin's Forestland Woody Biomass Harvesting Guidelines" (DNR Publication PUB-FR-435-2009) will be followed. Copy available at the LCFM office.
