Notice is hereby given that **Haas Sons, Inc.** has filed an application for a Conditional Use Permit and a Nonmetallic Mining Reclamation Permit to meet the requirements of the Chippewa County Zoning and Nonmetallic Mining Reclamation Ordinances, NMM Permit #2018-02.

Location: **NE ¼ of SE ¼ and NW ¼ of SE 1/4 of Section 3, T29N-R8W**

The applicant proposes to: **extract and crush sand and gravel, and to establish the post-mining land use as conservation lands; grassland/prairie. The proposed mine site will cover approximately 52 acres and will be sequentially mined and reclaimed in progressive stages.**

A combined hearing on the conditional use permit application and reclamation plan will be held on Thursday, August 23, 2018, in Room 302 at the Chippewa County Courthouse. The hearing, pursuant to Chippewa County Zoning Ordinance 70-71(b)(2) and NR 135.20(2), will commence at 4:30 p.m.

The hearing will be conducted for the purpose of explaining and receiving comments from affected persons on the proposed mining and reclamation.
