Explanatory Notes:

1. Per NR 135.39, annual fees are applied on an annual basis and are based on the acres of unreclaimed disturbance.
2. Per NR 135.39, annual fees for permitted mines where non-metallic mining is permitted and approved, but where no non-metallic mining has yet taken place, are restricted. In these circumstances, a yearly administrative monitoring and permit tracking fee of \$500 will be charged to cover County costs. The State portion of the yearly permit monitoring and tracking fee will be \$15.
3. In circumstances where a mine opens midyear, the annual fee for the following year will be increased to reflect the acres of disturbance and the number of months that the mine was active during the year the mine was opened.
4. Fee adjustments between categories may be made to credit areas being used for approved non-metallic mine reclamation test plots or demonstration areas, or to credit areas within the mine where successful reclamation has been completed and certified by the County.
5. Annual fees will include additional charges for nutrient management plan review and monitoring fees for permitted mines with agricultural croplands subject to nutrient management requirements.
6. Annual permit fees for bedrock mines more than 300 acres may be charged based upon the actual costs incurred by the County to monitor and assure compliance with the reclamation plan and permit.
7. In circumstances where a permit is transferred & no plan amendment is required, a \$1,000 transfer fee will be charged.
8. In addition to the listed fees, applicants shall be responsible for the payment of all reasonable legal expenses of the Land Conservation & Forest Management Committee for retaining outside expertise if needed to monitor or assure compliance with individual permit conditions, and the general requirements of the Non Metallic Mining Reclamation Ordinance.
