Sale Area Description:

The boundaries of this sale are marked with red paint lines. In order to regenerate the timber type this area will be clear-cut to promote a coppice of aspen

Cutting Requirements:


Clear-cut Area: Cut all trees one inch in diameter and larger. **Do Not** any conifer trees or pole sized oaks.

Special Conditions:

- No harvesting activity will be allowed if rutting occurs.
- No equipment operation is allowed within 15 feet of wetland areas
- All logging debris must remain within the sale boundaries and keep from wetland
- All landing location must be approved, all merchantable timber removed must be utilized and accounted for through mill slips and log scales.
- Leave all snags (dead trees) unless they present a safety hazard. Use caution to limit the disturbance of Course Woody Debris (CWD) on the forest floor. (i.e.) down logs greater than 12 inches in diameter.
- All hardwood logs, (except aspen) 10 inches or larger on the small end will be charged at the appropriate saw log stumpage rate.
- The contract length is 2.5 years
