

## **CHIPPEWA COUNTY TIMBER SALE TRACT 17-19**

### **Deer Fly ROW Sale**

Located in Sec 19&30 T32N R8W, Sec 36 T32N R8W, Sec 1, 11&14 T31N R8W Town of Cleveland  
Total Sale Area: +/- 39 acres

The table below contains an estimate of the amount of each species/product. There is no minimum bid for each species; however **the total minimum bid that is acceptable for Tract 17-19 is \$28,276.**

### **Sale Area Description:**

The boundaries of this sale are marked with red and blue paint lines. In order to improve road conditions the Deer Fly Right of Way (ROW) will be cleared of trees for 20+/- feet where there is merchantable timber. There are also two Oak stands along the road which will be selectively harvested.

### **Cutting Requirements:**

Selection Harvest Area: Cut all trees marked with orange paint, including non-commercial trees marked with orange paint. Do not cut sale boundary trees (red or blue paint).

Clear-cut Area: Cut all trees one inch in diameter and larger. **Do not** cut any trees marked with paint or conifers. The boundaries of the sale are marked with red paint. Private property boundaries are marked with blue paint.

### **Special Conditions:**

- No harvesting activity will be allowed if rutting occurs.
- To avoid damaging the road Harvesting will not be allowed during Spring Break Up. There must be dry or frozen ground conditions as determined by the County Forest Administrator, restriction is dependent on weather, likely restricted from March 1-May 15.
- No equipment operation is allowed within wetland areas if any are found within the site.
- All logging debris must remain within the sale boundaries and kept from wetlands, lakes and trails.
- All landing locations must be approved. All merchantable timber that is removed along landings or skid trails must be utilized and accounted for through mill slips or log scales.
- *Leave all snags (dead trees) unless they present a safety hazard. Use caution to limit the disturbance of Course Woody Debris (CWD) on the forest floor. (ie) down logs greater than 12 inches in diameter.*
- All hardwood logs, (except aspen) 10" or larger on the small end will be charged at the appropriate saw log stumpage rate.
- The contract length is 2 years.
