A parcel of land located in the west one half of Section 29, Township 28 North, Range 9 West, Town of Wheaton, Chippewa County, Wisconsin described as follows:

Beginning at the west $\frac{1}{4}$ corner of said Section 29; thence northerly along the west line of said Section 29, a distance of 1735.5 feet, more or less, to the southwest corner of Joseph E. Hawkins lands is occupied; thence easterly along the south line of said Hawkins lands, 1975.6 feet, more or less; thence southerly along the west line of said Hawkins lands 1744.4 feet, more or less, to an occupied east-west fence line; thence westerly along said occupied line 1975.7 feet to the point of beginning.

Parcel contains approximately 79 acres.

6. There will be no requirement for site dewatering.

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OPERATION

1. Materials to be extracted are base coarse and fill.
2. The extraction operation will consist of wheel loaders removing material from mined face and depositing into primary crusher which feeds reject screen which sends product onto secondary crusher and deposits excess sand onto reject pile.
3. Cell #1 when complete will yield approximately 150, 000 ton of base coarse. At this time Cell #1 is about 50% mined.
During the permit period, depending upon level of economic activity, approximately 150,000 ton will be extracted.
The entire site should be mined when the lease term expires. It is estimated the entire site contains 350,000 tons of usable material.
4. There will be no site dewatering or effluent discharge.

7. Topsoil from Cell #1 has been placed in berms and seeded. Subsoil has been placed in mined areas awaiting leveling to the correct elevation.

8. The cessation of mining operations on this site should parallel the enclosed lease- by the end of 2003. Cell #1 should be completely mined in two years - then the remaining three years to mine, Cell #2. Cell #1 will be reclaimed 1 year after it is completely mined.

(3.) FINAL SITE DESCRIPTION

This site is a series of hills within a farm field, the plan is to remove the hills leaving a field that commences at existing elevation on west mining site boundary and ends at the 900 contour line which is the east mining site boundary. Top soil will be reapplied and owner will plant agricultural crops.
