CHECKLIST OF REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- **If filing together:**

Joint Petition: With Minor Children **FA-4110V**
Without Minor Children **FA-4111V**

OR

If other party will need to be served:

Summons & Petition: With Minor Children **FA-4104V & FA-4108V**
Without Minor Children **FA-4105V & FA-4109V**

- Financial Disclosure Statement: (1 required for each party) **FA-4139V**
- Marital Settlement Agreement: (requires both party signatures) With Minor Children **FA-4150V**
Without Minor Children **FA-4151V**
- Proof of Attending Parenting Classes (if applicable)
- Divorce/Annulment Worksheet (at COC Office only, do **not** complete for legal separation)
- Confidential Petition Addendum: **GF-179**

A final hearing will not be set until all documents are filed; the final hearing date will be after the 120-day waiting period has expired.

If unable to reach an agreement, you may schedule a status conference by contacting the Judicial Assistant.

Any party on **active military duty and will **not** be appearing at the time of a final divorce hearing **must** have on file with the Clerk of Courts Office a notarized statement waiving their right to appear in reference to the Soldiers and Sailors Act. A final divorce **cannot** proceed without this document **
