Summary: Under this Wisconsin Statute, a person is immune from civil liability for acts or omissions related to his or her participation in equine activities if a person participating in the equine activity is injured or killed as the result of an inherent risk of equine activities. Notably, the statute provides that a person whose only involvement in an equine activity is as a spectator shall not be considered to be participating in the equine activity. The immunity does not apply if the person seeking immunity knowingly provided faulty tack or equipment, failed to make reasonable and prudent efforts to determine the ability of the participant to engage safely in the equine activity, owns or otherwise is in lawful possession of the land or facilities upon which the participant sustained injuries because of a known dangerous latent condition, or if he or she commits an act or omission that constitutes willful or wanton disregard for the safety of the participant or intentionally injures the participant. The statute also requires the visible displaying of warning signs or by bold print in a written waiver that alerts participants to the limitation of liability by law.

The Chippewa Valley Trail Riders (CVTR) and the Chippewa County Department of Land Conservation & Forest Management welcome you to enjoy ~25 miles of equestrian trail. CVTR members have developed and maintain the trail network and trailheads.

There are two trailheads with gravel parking, toilet facilities, fire pits, and tie lines. Hay Meadow #2 is located ~1/2 mile north of 225th Avenue on the Hay Meadow Trail forest road. Hay Meadow #3 is located ~one mile north of #2 on the east side of Hay Meadow Trail forest road. No potable water is available on-site at either trailhead.

The Chippewa County Forest is certified to be sustainably managed by the Forest Stewardship Council. Among other things, this certification requires scientific and professional forestry practices and control of erosion, sedimentation, and compaction from forestry operations and recreational trail use.

- Please respect all natural resources.
- Pack out what you bring in.
- Be courteous to others. Be aware that a few trails intersect mountain bike trails.
- Respectful communication between users is key to safety and enjoyment.


