


Hallie Marsh Wildlife Area (760 acres)

Land Open To The Public Within Sections 16, 17, 20, and 21, T28N R8W, Chippewa County, WI.



- Kemper's Woods is owned and managed by Chippewa County.
- The Hallie Marsh Wildlife Area is owned and managed by the WDNR – subject to State hunting regs.
- Use of pistols and rifles is prohibited by local Ordinance.
- No parking is allowed along the shoulder of 40th Ave. or 160th Street.
- Off-road use of motor vehicles (Including ATV's) is prohibited.
- Keep off of adjacent private lands.
- Discharge of firearms is prohibited within Kemper's Woods. Kemper's Woods is open to whitetail deer and wild turkey hunting, by archery only, during the following time periods only:

Wild Turkey: Start of 1st Season through the 1st Sunday in May; and, September 30 through the end of the fall season.

Whitetail Deer: November 1 through the end of archery season.
