GOVERNMENT CORNER MONUMENTATION REIMBURSEMENT POLICY
Revised: March 21, 2014

Government corners are defined as the corners set during the original Federal Government Survey, i.e. section corners, 1/4 corners, meander corners, and witness corners. 1/16 corners including center of section are not eligible for reimbursement.

In order for the Registered Land Surveyor to be eligible for reimbursement the following must be met:

The Registered Land Surveyor applying for reimbursement must make a written request on a form supplied by the Land Records Division. The request will expire 6 months after application if not completed.

Each Registered Land Surveyor must execute a reimbursement agreement with Chippewa County in order to be eligible.

A \$275.00 (two hundred and seventy five dollars) fee will be paid for each Government Corner monumented EXCEPT Government Corners located within or near a road right-of-way will be reimbursed \$150.00 (one hundred and fifty dollars). The payment will be made while funds are available on a first come first served basis, but not necessarily in the order that the applications are made. The completed "U.S. Public Survey Monumentation Record" along with a copy of the survey map for the property owner, must accompany the invoice from the Registered Land Surveyor.

All requirements as listed in Wisconsin Administrative code A-E 7.08 "U.S. Public Survey Monument Record" must be complied with.

Measurements are to be made to the nearest one hundredth of a foot from the Government Corner to each of four rebar witness monuments. Also, measurements to the nearest one hundredth of a foot are to be shown between the four rebar witness monuments. All witness monuments, Government Corner monuments, signs and posts are to be supplied by the Land Records Division. One caution sign and post are to be placed near the corner or near one of the rebar witnesses.

Government Corners which have "U.S. Public Land Survey Monument Records" or "Tie Sheets" on file in the Land Records Division office are not eligible for this program.
