



1. Go to the Chippewa County Mapping Website. Click "OK" on disclaimer.

2. In the right hand column, click on the folder next to "Tax Deed" to turn the current tax deed listing on or off.




3. Click on the box next to "Current Tax Deed Properties". This will toggle the layer on or off



5. First, click "Search" in the line of tools, and then click on the "Search by Parcel ID" in the right hand column.



6. First, type the Parcel ID in the empty box, then click "Go!"



7. After clicking “Go!” above, the program will zoom you to the location of the parcel number that you inserted. It will be highlighted with a purple outline in the middle of the screen. The right hand column will contain some information about the parcel. In the middle ribbon, you can click on the magnifying glass with the “+” or the “-” to zoom in or zoom out, respectively. Also, in the upper right-hand corner of the map, you can toggle on/off the most recent “Aerial” photo.



8. If you notice, the middle of the parcel is designated with a purple star. If you zoom out, you should notice the other tax deed properties around the county with the same purple star. Or you can go back to step 5 and repeat for additional properties.
